Attila Tanács has been a self-employed farmer since 2006, who was granted within a young farmer support scheme to purchase a tractor and farm machinery, in addition to land. His main motivation to embark on farming was family traditions. The farm is located at Öttömös, tanya 34. He keeps 10 beef cattle, and cultivates an area of 10 ha. Produced vegetables are asparagus on 1.3 ha, peppers on 0.5 ha, zucchini, pumpkin, patisson on a total of 2 ha, and the rest of the area is used for potato production. The manager of the farm is Attila Tanács, who hold a non-agricultural higher level degree, he graduated from university as a product designer and mechanical engineer. The farm has an established cooperation with mainly purchasers of the area buy the vegetables produced on the farm, the National Chamber of Agriculture, and it does not participate in any other type of cooperation or professional organisations. The farmer is not a member of a farmers' association.

Main advantages of the cooperations established area the provision of the market for the vegetables produced (through the purchasers), and the access to agricultural financial support, to which the cooperation with the National Chamber of Agriculture contributes. The nature of cooperation is mainly the use of services (sales) and the transfer of information, as well as individual consultation with the village farmer. The farm cooperates with other farmers in connection with its activities, within the framework of this cooperation spreading organic manure and harvesting is implemented by farmer partners. This is mainly due to the fact that the farm does now have the machinery necessary for the work processes involved. The farm is distinguished from other farms mainly by the cultivation of asparagus, which is a unique type of crop in the area. Among his long-term goals is further expansion of the cultivated area, which is to be financed through grant schemes.
