Salaš Cibajky is an agrotourism facility located in Klátová Nová Ves in the Tribeč Mountains. The owner of the farm was Vladimír Hamara (father), who in 2014 and 2015 implemented a project related to the reconstruction of the house into a low-capacity accommodation facility, which he still implements as his main activity. Since 2006, the farm has operated in a certified system of organic farming. In the restaurant within the framework of agrotourism they offer exclusively their products such as unpasteurized sheep and goat cheese, milk, bryndza and žinčica (sheep milk whey) also for the purpose of sale directly from the yard. His son Vladimir Hamara junior in 2015 completed his bachelor's degree at the Slovak University of Agriculture in Nitra.

In 2016 (in February) Mr. Hamara Jr. asked the municipal authority to issue a certificate of selfemployed farmer, through which he wants to develop his business intentions independently and thus take over part of the production of his father. The owner of the company is only as a natural person belonging to the category of a young entrepreneur in agriculture. He gained experience working in agriculture from his parents, where he helped to perform agricultural support work from an early age.

Doing business in agriculture depends not only on the weather but also on the geographical location. For this reason, its agricultural activity will focus on sheep, cattle, and horses.

By renting land, the company wants to develop business in primary agricultural production.

Vladimir is a young farmer and with his theoretical and practical knowledge as well as experience and adherence to agrotechnical and veterinary principles he wants to prove that if he wants and the conditions are created, he can manage a profit. Agriculture is a sector of the national economy whose results depend on the weather, but the state must also work on the results and prosperity of agriculture to make sure that what we produce is not for sale. It is necessary to introduce rules into supplier-customer relations, according to which he would be guided by their intentions.

The farm is focused on breeding horses, sheep and dairy cows with subsequent milk production.

The farm development project envisages a gradual increase in the number of animals so that the farm is viable. It is evident that the young novice farmer does not have enough funds to use to start an agricultural business.
